Educational Audiology added to the Doctorate of Audiology

This summer, two of our Outreach Educational Audiologists,
Shannon Stafford and Sheryl Whiteman,
are teaching a course at Indiana University in Bloomington.

The course, Educational Audiology, was recently added to the Au.D (Doctorate of Audiology) curriculum at the university. This is the second time they will have taught the course. With their extensive experience, Shannon and Sheryl will cover a variety of services provided to children from birth through the age of 21. Some of the topics that will be covered in this 8-week course will focus on audiology services and educational considerations for children with hearing loss in relation to early intervention, educational laws and related topics (i.e., IDEA, 504, FAPE, LRE) and working with children with multiple abilities. The end goal is to provide the audiology students with basic knowledge and exposure to working with the early intervention and educational systems to best meet the audiological needs of individual children.

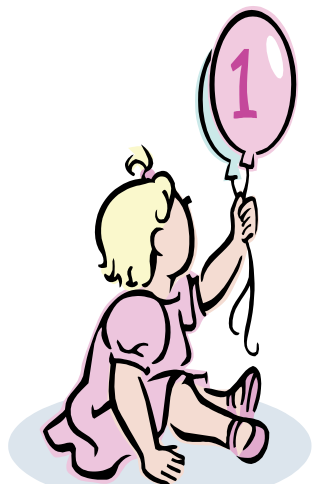

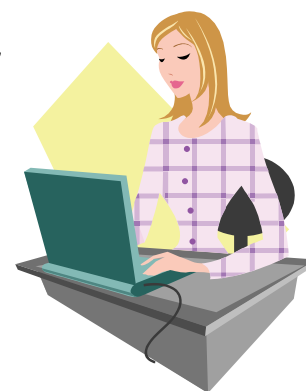

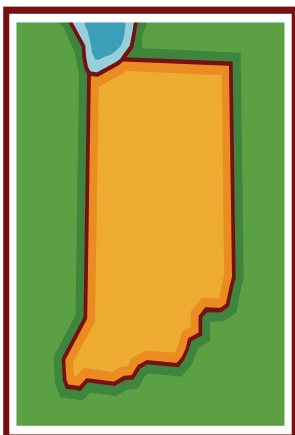
